



TO DOWNTOWN HALF MOON BAY!
One of the most charming downtown areas around, with unique shops, eateries, inns, and wonderful places to explore. Eat, shop and stay a while!

Dating back to the 1840s, the community that is today called Half Moon Bay is the oldest community in San Mateo County. Cabrillo Highway (California Rt. 1) along the coast, and San Mateo Road (Hwy 92) over the mountains follow closely the earliest trails of the original Costanoan Indians, who lived here for thousands of years.

The City of Half Moon Bay was incorporated in 1959. It is now a town of approximately 12,500 people. It has many reminders of its early beginnings in the mid-1800s as an agricultural town. Fields of flowers, artichokes, brussel sprouts, Christmas trees, pumpkins and other crops blanket the breathtaking landscape.



Half Moon Bay has been diligent in preserving its history, with traces of its past visible in the many historic buildings in downtown Half Moon Bay. The historic business district still shows signs of what downtown was like in earlier days.
